



Rebel DanceSport Competitor Agreement

As a member of Rebel DanceSport, you represent our team both on and off the dance floor. To ensure clear communication, strong teamwork, and professional conduct, all members are expected to adhere to the following guidelines.

1. Competition Registration

All team members attending a competition and representing Rebel DanceSport will be registered for the competition by the Rebel DanceSport team captain. The team captain will make all competitors aware of any requirements and deadlines through Discord through the announcements channel. If a competitor fails to respond to the team captain by the deadline, that competitor may consequently face certain exclusions, such as losing early registration discounts, lodging, or the ability to attend the competition as a whole.

If a team member will be unable to communicate and lets the team captain know ahead of time, the team will make reasonable efforts to accommodate that member.

2. Partnering Requirements

All competitors must have a partner to compete with in at least one event. The team captain will not register a dancer who has no partner.

3. Payment and Deadlines

Competition fees are payable directly to Rebel DanceSport via Zelle, or directly to the team captain in cash. Team members who fail to meet the payment deadline may either:

- a) face a late registration penalty
- b) lose access to team-arranged lodging and transportation
- c) be unable to attend the competition at all

Refunds are available until the payment deadline.

4. Lodging and Travel

The team captain will arrange for lodging and facilitate carpooling for those representing Rebel DanceSport at a competition. The team captain will pay for lodging, and may house up to four in a room and up to two in a bed that is Queen or larger. The team captain will make an effort to accommodate preferences if given reasonable notice, but it cannot be guaranteed.

Team members will treat their lodgings and means of transportation with respect, and are responsible for any damage they may cause.

Competitors who wish to find their own travel or lodging may do so at their own cost.

5. Being Considerate of Those Around You

Team members sharing transportation, a room, or any personal space with others should be considerate when determining how many bags to bring, how to unpack in the room, and how to share the space in general. Team members should also maintain personal hygiene, including washing their hair and bodies, applying deodorant, maintaining oral hygiene, washing clothing, and any other reasonable aspect of hygiene that could affect the comfort of those in close proximity.

6. Behavior at Competition

Competitors should follow all rules and regulations set forth by the competition organizers and by Rebel DanceSport.

Team members should treat those around them with respect and behave in a way that reflects positively on Rebel DanceSport. Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated. If a conflict between two members arises and is unable to be solved, competitors should notify the team captain who will attempt to mediate the situation.

Any space at a competition used by Rebel DanceSport members should be kept clean, tidy, and should not unnecessarily sprawl into the space of others. The area should moreover be left in the same condition it was found in.

Team members who behave improperly at competitions may be suspended from attending future competitions with Rebel DanceSport at the discretion of the Executive Board.

7. Substances and Illicit Activity

Throughout the duration of the event, team members traveling for a competition or other event endorsed by Rebel DanceSport should not possess or consume alcohol or cannabis, and should not come into contact with firearms, explosives, or weapons, even when not prohibited by law. They should also not be in possession of any other illicit substances or objects, nor should they violate any applicable laws, ordinances, or rules of UNLV.
